University of New Mexico School of Medicine



The UNM Department of Dermatology seeks energetic qualified individuals for two full-time faculty positions (General Dermatology and Pediatric Dermatology) to join our inclusive, innovative, mission-oriented team. We serve a large, uniquely diverse, medically complex population and are the consultative resource for the entire state of New Mexico and the Four Corners region of the Southwest. We provide the highest quality service in general/complex medical and pediatric dermatology, cutaneous oncology, dermatologic/Mohs surgery, aesthetics/laser, and dermatopathology (Tricore Reference Laboratories). We collaborate with nearly every service at the UNM Health System and have strong partnerships in our communities providing quaternary access to care. Clinical responsibilities include ambulatory dermatology and sharing dedicated coverage of UNM Hospital consultations (adult and pediatric). We are currently specifically seeking potential faculty members with expertise and interest in hospital dermatology. The training program is accredited through ACGME for three residents per year (nine total) and faculty have active teaching and service engagements in coordination with the School of Medicine. Opportunities for clinical research are also available.

The University of New Mexico Health Sciences Center (HSC) is the only academic health complex in the state and is located on the UNM campus in beautiful Albuquerque, New Mexico. The UNM HSC prioritizes resources to its four mission areas - Education, Research, Patient Care and Community Outreach - to provide New Mexicans with the highest level of health care.
